Statement of Registrable Interests for Dáil Éireann (Blue) and Statement of Registrable Interests for Seanad Éireann (Yellow) Statement of Registrable Interests (SORI) - Ethics in Public Office Acts 1995 and 2001

An "Office Holder" is a Minister, Minister of State, Ceann Comhairle, Leas-Ceann Comhairle, Cathaoirleach or Leas-Chathaoirleach.
