who were <u>not</u> members of the previous Seanad or Dáil during 2011:	from: date of election to 31 st Dáil to: 31 December 2011

PART 1 - OCCUPATIONAL INCOME etc.

Complete columns (i) and (ii) below in respect of any remunerated trade, profession, employment, vocation or other occupation (*other* than that of office holder or member) held by you while you were a member of either House at any time during the period 1 January 2011 to 31 December 2011. You are only

required to register any occupation (including occupation as a landlord) etc., the remuneration from which exceeded €2,600 in the stated period. You are not required to give details of the actual amount of remuneration.
